

STRATHALBYN MODEL AIRCRAFT CLUB INC

NOISE LIMIT RULING FEBRUARY 2008

All aircraft, whether owned by a Club member, or a visitor to the Club, and at the discretion of the Safety Officers or Chief Flying Instructor, must be presented for a noise level test before being permitted to fly.

The aircraft noise will be measured in accordance with the standard testing procedures using the decibel meter owned and operated by the Strathalbyn Model Aircraft Club Inc.. Testing will follow the M.A.A.A guidelines and the noise reading, when taken from any point at a distance of 3 metres from the aircraft, and at a height of 1 metre above the aircraft, will not exceed 97 decibels.

In the event of a change of engine, exhaust system, or propeller, it will be the responsibility of the owner to submit his / her aircraft for re-testing.

The owner's name, aircraft description, propeller size and brand, noise level recorded, and date shall be entered into a club log book for future reference.

There shall be no excuse for flying an untested aircraft.

Repeated breaches of this ruling may result in penalties being applied.
